Submission Text:

I believe that a human rights document which is implemented in legislation for asylum seekers particularly is very necessary to protect their rights. Mandatory detention does not conform to the right to freedom and the conditions in which people are currently held in detention centres in NSW are unacceptable.

All asylum seekers freedom should be protected by having the right to get appropriate information from independent and properly accredited lawyers. Their freedom is presently further curtailed by not being able to walk without meeting bars and barriers.

This is only one aspect of the rights of asylum seekers being abused in Australia.
